PORT KLANG CONTAINER CONGESTION & OPERATIONAL IMPACT

The Association of Malaysian Hauliers (AMH) wishes to inform that **severe operational congestion is currently occurring at Port Klang**, affecting both main terminals and off-dock container depots.

This situation is primarily due to:

- **Terminal yard density exceeding operational capacity,**
- **High volume of import and export containers,** and
- **Restricted evacuation flow,** resulting in significant spillover to external depots.

As a result, hauliers are experiencing:

- Substantially longer turnaround times,
- Delays in container movement and slot availability, and
- Operational disruptions that are **beyond the control of individual haulier operators.**

AMH would like to emphasise that these delays are **industry-wide in nature** and are **not attributable to the performance or negligence of individual hauliers.**

AMH is currently **engaging with port stakeholders**, including terminal operators and depot operators, to identify short-term mitigation measures aimed at reducing the impact on the logistics supply chain. This advisory is issued for **industry clarification purposes** and may be used by AMH members as an **official reference when communicating with their customers.**

AMH will continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide further updates as developments arise.
